



Join Our Team: Maternity Home Live-In Caregiver

Location: Vancouver, BC

Position Type: Full-time, Live-in (Minimum 1-year commitment)

Reports To: Program Director, Cedar Pregnancy Care Centre (CPCC)

About the Role

The Christian Advocacy Society is seeking a dedicated woman to serve as a **Live-In Caregiver** at the Nest. Working as a team with a co-caregiver, you will cultivate a safe, clean, and peaceful community for expectant and new mothers. In this role, you will provide spiritual, emotional, and practical support to house residents, offering friendship, support, and hands-on assistance as they transition into motherhood.

Key Responsibilities

Client Support & Community Life

- Provide regular check-ins, peer support, and friendship to residents.
- Assist moms with practical baby care (e.g., hold the baby while mom cleans.)
- Arrange house meals and client meetings 1–2 times per month.
- Assist the Maternity Home Coordinator (MHC) with client intakes and transitions (move-ins/outs).

Home Operations & Administration

- Maintain the house cleaning schedule, manage grocery lists, and coordinate maintenance needs with tradespeople.
- Keep accurate incident reports and provide timely client updates to the MHC.
- Supervise and guide Maternity Home volunteers, particularly when the MHC is absent.
- Attend monthly Maternity Home meetings and participate in weekly prayer with the MHC.
- Support the Christian Advocacy Society (CAS) by attending meetings and assisting with fundraisers.

Position Requirements & Terms

- **Live-In Commitment:** This is a full-time, live-in position requiring a minimum one-year commitment.
- **Compensation:** A stipend is provided in the form of **free room and board**.

Schedule & Availability:

- Expected to be onsite at least three evenings per week.
- Receive 1–2 free weekends per month (vacation time negotiated with the Program Director).
- Caregivers share holiday coverage, ensuring at least one caregiver is onsite for part of the day during major holidays (Christmas, Thanksgiving, Mother's Day) to celebrate with residents.





- **Transportation:** A valid driver's license and a reliable vehicle are preferred but not required.
- **Personal Wellness:** To ensure long-term success and personal well-being, maintaining an outside social and spiritual support network (such as a life or home group) is required.
- **Evaluation:** Includes a 3-month probationary review, followed by annual written and oral evaluations by the Program Director.
